

Coaching Code of Conduct

Spirit League is committed to the highest ideals of sportsmanship and expects all Coaches to act in a manner that both contributes to the overall mission of Spirit League and follows Spirit League policies. All Spirit League Coaches agree to observe the following Code of Conduct:

Respect for Others

- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of athletes, Coaches, other volunteers, friends and spectators in Spirit League.
- I will treat everyone equally regardless of sex, ethnic origin, religion or ability.
- I will respect the privacy issues concerning families and their child's disabilities.
- I will be a positive role model for the athletes.
- I will respect the property of athletic facilities.

Ensure a Positive Experience

- I will ensure that Spirit League is a positive experience for the athletes. Winning is not the goal!
- I will be fair, considerate and honest with athletes and communicate in simple language with athletes using simple, clear language.
- I will attend any Spirit League games, practices, or events in the Team Mentor shirt provided.

Act Professionally and Take Responsibility for My Actions

- I will provide for the general welfare, health and safety of any Spirit League athlete in my chargeduring my assigned duties.
- My language, manner, punctuality, preparation and presentation will demonstrate professionalism.
- I will encourage athletes to demonstrate the same qualities as above.
- I will not take part in smoking or chewing tobacco at any Spirit League site, except in designated areas.
- I will not drink alcohol or take illegal drugs while representing Spirit League at any Spirit League events.

• I will refrain from any form of abuse towards athletes and others, including verbal, physical and emotional abuse.

Quality Service to the Athletes

- I will assist to provide the highest quality service possible.
- I will be a positive role model for the athletes in the program.

Health and Safety of the Athletes

- I will assist in ensuring that the equipment and facilities are safe to use.
- I will encourage athletes to seek medical advice when required.
- I will maintain the same interest and support towards all athletes.
