Where do children on the autism spectrum in Orange County go when they want to be part of a team; when they want to play sports like the other children in the neighborhood? They go to Spirit League. Spirit League allows children and young adults with special needs the opportunity to play team sports in a positive, self-esteem building environment.

Founded in 2004, Spirit League was created by parents of children who were unable to fully participate in team sports due to challenges. Spirit League is tailored to meet the specific needs of children on the autism spectrum and other developmental or physical disabilities who are between the ages of 6 and 20+ years old and are ambulatory.

- **For our athletes**, our goal is to foster self-esteem, enhance social skills and build friendships.
- **For our families**, our goal is to strengthen relationships, provide support and develop community.
- We highly recommend Spirit League. It is a safe environment where your child and family will have fun and meet some of the best people around.





About the Sports

Spirit League programs are co-ed and offer participants an opportunity to build self-esteem, create friendships, experience teamwork and have lots of fun.

Seasons


Our athletes are divided into 3 different age divisions as follows:

- Division 1 (13 20+ years);
- Division 2 (9 13 years); and
- Division 3 (6 9 years).

Divisions

Spirit League offers 3 sport seasons each year. The majority of our athletes participate in more than one season per year which include:

- Basketball (January March);
- Baseball (April June); and
- Soccer (September November).
